A BILL

To amend the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 to establish the reportable quantity for sulfur dioxide as 1,000 pounds.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORTABLE QUANTITY FOR SULFUR DIOXIDE.**

4 Section 304(a) of the Superfund Amendments and
5 Reauthorization Act of 1986 is amended by adding the
6 following at the end thereof:

7 “(4) REPORTABLE QUANTITY FOR SULFUR DI-
8 OXIDE.—Effective on the date of the enactment of

1 this paragraph, the reportable quantity of sulfur di-
2 oxide for purposes of notification under this section
3 and section 103(a) of the Comprehensive Environ-
4 mental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act
5 of 1980 shall be 1,000 pounds.”.
