3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO PART B OF**
4 **TITLE XVIII.**

5 (a) REQUIREMENTS FOR SUPPLIERS OF MEDICAL
6 EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES.—Section 1834(j) of the So-
7 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395m(j)), as added by sec-

1 tion 131(a) of the Social Security Act Amendments of
2 1994, is amended—

3 (1) in paragraph (3), by amending the heading
4 to read as follows: “COVERAGE AND UTILIZATION
5 REVIEW CRITERIA”; and

6 (2) in paragraph (4)(F)(v), by striking
7 “1861(s)(2)(P)” and inserting “1861(s)(2)(O)”.

8 (b) BENEFICIARY LIABILITY FOR NONCOVERED
9 SERVICES.—Section 133(a)(2) of the Social Security Act
10 Amendments of 1994 is repealed.

11 **SEC. 2. STUDY OF AGGREGATION RULE FOR CLAIMS OF**
12 **SIMILAR PHYSICIAN SERVICES.**

13 Section 4113 of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation
14 Act of 1990 is amended—

15 (1) by inserting “of the Social Security Act”
