A BILL

For the relief of Miron Kharchilava.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANT OF NATURALIZATION TO MIRON**
4 **KHARCHILAVA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any requirement
6 of the Immigration and Nationality Act or any other provi-
7 sion of law, Miron Kharchilava shall be naturalized as a
8 citizen of the United States upon the filing of the appro-
9 priate application and upon being administered the oath
10 of renunciation and allegiance in an appropriate ceremony
11 pursuant to section 337 of the Immigration and National-
12 ity Act.

1 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
2 FEES.—Subsection (a) shall apply only if the application
3 for naturalization is filed with appropriate fees within 1
4 year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
