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## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on dichlorofopmethyl.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.30.16	Methyl 2-[4-(2,4-dichlorophenoxy)phenoxy]propanoate (dichlorofopmethyl) in bulk or in forms or packages for retail sale (CAS No. 51338-27-3) (provided for in sub-heading 2918.90.20 or 3808.30.15) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/98	”.
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1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 this section applies with respect to goods entered, or with-  
3 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the  
4 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
