Mr. FALEOMAVEGA introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To amend the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act to make the provisions and benefits of Indian self-determination contracts applicable to Indian self-governance compacts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 403 of the Indian Self-Determination and
4 Education Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 458cc) is amended
5 by adding at the end the following:

6 “(l) INCORPORATION OF TITLE I PROVISIONS.— For
7 the purposes of the following sections of title I of this Act,
8 the term ‘contract’ also includes agreements authorized by

1 this title and title III: 5(f)(1), 7(b), 7(c), 8, 102(d), 103,
2 104, 105(a)(3), 105(f), 105(k), 105(n) (at the election of,
3 and subject to any phase-in period established by, any
4 compact tribe, or any consortium of tribes that is a party
5 to an annual funding agreement, in Alaska), 106(a),
6 106(b), 106(d), 106(e), 106(f), 106(j), 106(k), 106(m),
7 106(n), 110 and 111; and subsections (b)(5),
8 (b)(6)(B)(iii), (b)(7)(A), (b)(8) (D) through (G), (b)(9),
9 and (b)(10) of section 1 of the model agreement set forth
10 in section 108(c).”.
