A BILL

To prohibit Federal agencies from planning the sale of the
Southeastern Power Administration.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON STUDY.**

4 Neither the Department of Energy, the United States
5 Army Corp of Engineers, the Department of the Interior,
6 nor any other department, agency, or instrumentality of
7 the United States may undertake any plan regarding, or
8 commence negotiating, the sale of the Southeastern Power
9 Administration, including the dams, lakes, locks, and res-
10 ervoires, or any other facilities used in connection with the

1 generation of electric energy marketed by the Southeast-
2 ern Power Administration.
