## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to eliminate certain sentencing inequities for drug offenders.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Mandatory Federal  
5 Prison Drug Treatment Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF SENTENCING INEQUITIES FOR**  
7 **DRUG OFFENDERS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section  
9 3621(e)(2)(B) of title 18, United States Code, is amended  
10 to read as follows:

1           “(B) ELIGIBILITY FOR GOOD TIME.—If a  
2           prisoner is eligible for the substance abuse  
3           treatment program, good time credit for that  
4           prisoner under section 3624(b) shall not vest  
5           unless the prisoner successfully completes such  
6           program, and remains drug free after the com-  
7           pletion of the program.”.

8           (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 3624(b) of  
9           title 18, United States Code, is amended by adding at the  
10          end the following:

11           “(5) Credit under this subsection for a prisoner  
12          who is eligible for a residential treatment program  
13          under section 3621(e), shall be limited in accordance  
14          with section 3621(e)(2)(B).”.

15          (c) ELIGIBILITY.—Clause       (ii)       of       section  
16          3621(e)(5)(B) of title 18, United States Code, is amended  
17          to read as follows:

18                           “(ii) within 24 months of the date of  
19                           release; and”.
