A BILL

To repeal the Medicare and Medicaid Coverage Data Bank.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF MEDICARE AND MEDICAID COV-**
4 **ERAGE DATA BANK.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1144 of the Social Secu-
6 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1320b–14), as added by section
7 13581(a) of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of
8 1993 (in this section referred to as “OBRA–93”), is re-
9 pealed.

10 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

1 (1) MEDICARE.—Section 1862(b)(5) of such
2 Act (42 U.S.C. 1395y(b)(5)), as amended by section
3 13581(b)(1) of OBRA–93, is amended—

4 (A) in subparagraph (B), by striking the
5 dash and all that follows through the end and
6 inserting “subparagraph (A) for purposes of
7 carrying out this subsection.”, and

8 (B) in subparagraph (C)(i), by striking
9 “subparagraph (B)(i)” and inserting “subpara-
10 graph (B)”.

11 (2) MEDICAID.—Section 1902(a)(25)(A)(i) of
12 such Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)(25)(A)(i)), as amend-
13 ed by section 13581(b)(2) of OBRA–93, is amended
14 by striking “including the use of” and all that fol-
15 lows through “any additional measures”.

16 (3) DATA MATCHES.—Section 552a(a)(8)(B) of
17 title 5, United States Code, as amended by section
18 13581(c) of OBRA–93, is amended—

19 (A) by adding “or” at the end of clause
20 (v),

21 (B) by striking “or” at the end of clause
22 (vi), and

23 (C) by striking clause (vii).

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
