**AN ACT**

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of certain hydroelectric projects in the State of Pennsylvania.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**

2 (a) **EXTENSION.**—Notwithstanding the time limita-  
3 tions of section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.  
4 806), upon the request of the licensee for the project con-  
5 cerned, and after reasonable notice, the Federal Energy  
6 Regulatory Commission shall, in accordance with the good  
7 faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements of  
8 such section 13 and the Commission’s procedures under  
9 such section, extend the time required for commencement  
10 of construction of each the following projects until Sep-  
11 tember 26, 1999:

12 (1) FERC Project No. 4474.

13 (2) FERC Project No. 7041.

14 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—This section shall take effect  
15 for the project upon the expiration of the extension (issued  
16 by the Commission under section 13 of the Federal Power  
17 Act (16 U.S.C. 806)) of the period required for commence-  
18 ment of construction of the project concerned.
