A BILL

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of 2 hydroelectric projects in North Carolina, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**

4 (a) ~~PROJECT NUMBERED 10812.—~~

1 (1) ~~IN GENERAL.~~—Notwithstanding the time
2 period specified in section 13 of the Federal Power
3 Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to
4 the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission project
5 numbered 10812, the Commission may, at the re-
6 quest of the licensee for the project, and after rea-
7 sonable notice, in accordance with the good faith,
8 due diligence, and public interest requirements of
9 that section and the Commission’s procedures under
10 that section, extend the time period during which
11 the licensee is required to commence the construc-
12 tion of the project, under the extension described in
13 paragraph (2), for not more than 5 consecutive 2-
14 year periods.

16 take effect on the date of the expiration of the ex-
17 tension of the period required for commencement of
18 construction of the project described in paragraph
19 (1) that the Commission issued, prior to the date of
20 enactment of this Act, under section 13 of the Fed-

3 of the licensee for the project, and after reasonable
4 notice, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-
5 gence, and public interest requirements of that sec-
6 tion and the Commission's procedures under that
7 section, extend the time period during which the li-
8 censee is required to commence the construction of
9 the project for not more than 5 consecutive 2-year
10 periods.

11 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This subsection shall
12 take effect on the date of the expiration of the pe-
13 riod required for commencement of construction of
14 the project under the license for the project.

21 bered 10812, the Commission shall, at the request of
22 the licensee for the project, and after reasonable no-
23 tice, in accordance with the good faith, due diligence,
24 and public interest requirements of that section and
25 the Commission's procedures under that section, ex-

1 *tend the time period during which the licensee is re-*
2 *quired to commence the construction of the project,*
3 *under the extension described in paragraph (2), for*
4 *not more than 3 consecutive 2-year periods.*

5 (2) *EFFECTIVE DATE.*—*This subsection shall take*
6 *effect on the date of the expiration of the extension of*
7 *the period required for commencement of construction*
8 *of the project described in paragraph (1) that the*
9 *Commission issued, prior to the date of enactment of*
10 *this Act, under section 13 of the Federal Power Act*
11 *(16 U.S.C. 806).*

12 (b) *PROJECT NUMBERED 6879.*—

13 (1) *IN GENERAL.*—*Notwithstanding the time pe-*
14 *riod specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act*
15 *(16 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the*
16 *Federal Energy Regulatory Commission project num-*
17 *bered 6879, the Commission may, at the request of the*
18 *licensee for the project, and after reasonable notice, in*
19 *accordance with the good faith, due diligence, and*
20 *public interest requirements of that section and the*
21 *Commission's procedures under that section, extend*
22 *the time period during which the licensee is required*
23 *to commence the construction of the project for not*
24 *more than 3 consecutive 2-year periods.*

1 (2) *EFFECTIVE DATE.*—*This subsection shall take*
2 *effect on the date of the expiration of the period re-*
3 *quired for commencement of construction of the*
4 *project under the license for the project.*

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
