Mr. KANJORSKI introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Banking and Financial Services

## A BILL

To authorize civil actions for certain violations involving depository institutions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Savings and Loan  
5 Asset Recovery Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CIVIL ACTIONS FOR CERTAIN VIOLATIONS INVOLV-**  
7 **ING DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS.**

8 Section 951 of the Financial Institutions Reform, Re-  
9 covery, and Enforcement Act of 1989 (12 U.S.C. 1833a)  
10 is amended by adding at the end the following:

1       “(g) CIVIL ACTIONS FOR CERTAIN VIOLATIONS.—A  
2 person may bring a civil action to assess a civil penalty  
3 for a violation referred to in subsection (c) in the same  
4 manner and subject to the same procedures as a person  
5 may bring an action under section 3730 of title 31, United  
6 States Code, for a violation of section 3729 of such title.”.
