A BILL

For the relief of Joel Andrew Dopp.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF CERTAIN NATURALIZATION RE-**
4 **QUIREMENTS FOR JOEL ANDREW DOPP.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the inability of
6 Joel Andrew Dopp to meet the requirements of section
7 316 of the Immigration and Nationality Act that relate
8 to residence and physical presence in the United States,
9 he shall be deemed eligible for naturalization upon the fil-
10 ing of the appropriate application if otherwise qualified for
11 naturalization under such Act.

1 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
2 FEES.—Subsection (a) shall apply only if the application
3 for naturalization is filed with appropriate fees within 2
4 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
