Mr. PALLONE (for himself and Mr. FRANKS of New Jersey) introduced the  
following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation  
and Infrastructure

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## A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 1992  
relating to sediments decontamination technology.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SEDIMENTS DECONTAMINATION TECHNOLOGY.**

4 Section 405 of the Water Resources Development Act  
5 of 1992 (106 Stat. 4683; 33 U.S.C. 2239 note) is amend-  
6 ed—

7 (1) by adding at the end of subsection (a)(2)  
8 the following: “The goal of the program shall be to  
9 make possible the development, on an operational  
10 scale, of 1 or more sediment decontamination tech-

1 nologies, each of which demonstrates a sediment de-  
2 contamination capacity of at least 5,000 cubic yards  
3 per day.”;

4 (2) by adding at the end of subsection (a) the  
5 following:

6 “(3) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than  
7 September 30, 1996, and September 30 of each year  
8 thereafter, the Administrator and the Secretary shall  
9 report to Congress on progress made toward the  
10 goal described in paragraph (2).”; and

11 (3) in subsection (c)—

12 (A) by striking “\$5,000,000” and inserting  
13 “\$10,000,000”; and

14 (B) by striking “1992” and inserting  
15 “1995”.

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
