## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to repeal the provision relating to Federal employees contracting or trading with Indians.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FEDERAL EMPLOYEES CONTRACTING OR**  
4 **TRADING WITH INDIANS.**

5 (a) REPEAL.—Section 437 of title 18, United States  
6 Code, is repealed.

7 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The table of sec-  
8 tions at the beginning of chapter 23 of title 18, United  
9 States Code, is amended by striking the item relating to  
10 section 437.

1       (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The repeal made by sub-  
2 section (a) shall—

3           (1) take effect on the date of enactment of this  
4 Act; and

5           (2) apply with respect to any contract obtained,  
6 and any purchase or sale occurring, on or after the  
7 date of enactment of this Act.
