A BILL

To require the President to submit a separately identified appropriation request to provide priority funding for the national parks of the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Crown Jewel National
5 Parks Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PRIORITY FUNDING REQUESTS FOR NATIONAL**
2 **PARKS.**

3 Section 1105(a) of title 31, United States Code, is
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(32) a separate statement of the amount of
6 appropriations requested for priority funding for
7 each national park, the Crown Jewels of the Na-
8 tional Park System, and a separate statement set-
9 ting forth the reasons why priority funding is not re-
10 quested for a national park (if any).”.
