## A BILL

To require that excess funds provided for official allowances of Members of the House of Representatives be dedicated to deficit reduction.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT THAT EXCESS FUNDS PRO-**  
4 **VIDED FOR OFFICIAL ALLOWANCES OF MEM-**  
5 **BERS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**  
6 **BE DEDICATED TO DEFICIT REDUCTION.**

7 Of the funds made available in any appropriation Act  
8 for fiscal year 1995 or any succeeding fiscal year for the  
9 official expenses allowance, the clerk hire allowance, or the  
10 official mail allowance of a Member of the House of Rep-

1 representatives, any amount that remains unobligated at the  
2 end of such fiscal year shall be transferred to the Deficit  
3 Reduction Fund established by Executive Order 12858  
4 (58 Fed. Reg. 42185). Any amount so transferred shall  
5 be in addition to the amounts specified in section 2(b) of  
6 such order, but shall be subject to the requirements and  
7 limitations set forth in sections 2(c) and 3 of such order.
