A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act to provide an enhanced penalty for distributing a controlled substance with the intent to facilitate a rape or sexual battery.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Drug-Induced Rape
5 Act of 1996”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISTRIBUTION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE WITH**
2 **INTENT TO FACILITATE A RAPE OR SEXUAL**
3 **BATTERY.**

4 Section 401(b) of the Controlled Substances Act is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(7)(A) Any person who violates subsection (a)
7 of this section by distributing a controlled substance
8 with the intent to facilitate conduct that would vio-
9 late section 2241(b)(1) or 2242(2) of title 18,
10 United States Code, if that conduct occurred in the
11 special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the
12 United States, shall be fined not more than
13 \$2,000,000 if the defendant is an individual and not
14 more than \$10,000,000 if the defendant is a person
15 other than an individual and imprisoned not less
16 than 20 years.

17 “(B) Notwithstanding any other provision of
18 law the court shall not place on probation or sus-
19 pend the sentence of any person sentenced under
20 this paragraph.”.
