## A BILL

To amend title III of the Job Training Partnership Act to provide employment and training assistance for individuals who work full-time at a plant, facility, or enterprise that is a part of an economically depressed industry and is located in an economically depressed area.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PROVISION OF EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING**  
2 **ASSISTANCE FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE EM-**  
3 **PLOYED AT A PLANT, FACILITY, OR ENTER-**  
4 **PRISE THAT IS A PART OF AN ECONOMI-**  
5 **CALLY DEPRESSED INDUSTRY AND IS LO-**  
6 **CATED IN AN ECONOMICALLY DEPRESSED**  
7 **AREA.**

8 Section 301(a)(1) of the Job Training Partnership  
9 Act (29 U.S.C. 1651(a)(1)) is amended—

10 (1) in subparagraph (C), by striking “or” at  
11 the end;

12 (2) in subparagraph (D), by striking the period  
13 at the end and inserting “; or”; and

14 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
15 paragraph:

16 “(E) are employed full-time at a plant, facility,  
17 or enterprise that is a part of an economically de-  
18 pressed industry and is located in an economically  
19 depressed area, as determined by the Secretary.”.
