## A BILL

To make a minor adjustment in the exterior boundary of the Devils Backbone Wilderness in the Mark Twain National Forest, Missouri, to exclude a small parcel of land containing improvements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT, DEVILS BACKBONE**  
4 **WILDERNESS, MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOR-**  
5 **EST, MISSOURI.**

6 Using the authority provided in section 202 of Public  
7 Law 96–560 (94 Stat. 3274) regarding the correction of

1 clerical errors in the maps and legal descriptions of the  
2 Devils Backbone Wilderness established by section 201(d)  
3 of such Act (16 U.S.C. 1132 note), the Secretary of Agri-  
4 culture shall adjust the exterior boundary of the Devils  
5 Backbone Wilderness in the Mark Twain National Forest,  
6 Missouri, to exclude a parcel of real property that consists  
7 of approximately a quarter of an acre in Douglas County,  
8 Missouri, contains a garage, well, mailbox, driveway, and  
9 other improvements, and was inadvertently removed from  
10 administration as National Forest System land and in-  
11 cluded within the wilderness area.
