Mr. PICKETT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on National Security

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Navy to transfer a riverine patrol boat of the U.S.S. Swift class to Tidewater Community College, Portsmouth, Virginia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF RIVERINE PATROL CRAFT.**

4 (a) AUTHORITY TO TRANSFER VESSEL.—Notwith-
5 standing subsections (a) and (d) of section 7306 of title
6 10, United States Code, but subject to subsections (b) and
7 (c) of that section, the Secretary of the Navy may transfer
8 a vessel described in subsection (b) to Tidewater Commu-

1 nity College, Portsmouth, Virginia, for scientific and edu-
2 cational purposes.

3 (b) VESSEL.—The authority under subsection (a) ap-
4 plies in the case of a riverine patrol craft of the U.S.S.
5 Swift class.

6 (c) LIMITATION.—The transfer authorized by sub-
7 section (a) may be made only if the Secretary determines
8 that the vessel to be transferred is of no further use to
9 the United States for national security purposes.

10 (d) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The Secretary may
11 require such terms and conditions in connection with the
12 transfer authorized by this section as the Secretary consid-
13 ers appropriate.
