A BILL

To extend the time for the submission of the final report of the Veterans' Claims Adjudication Commission.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF VETERANS' CLAIMS ADJUDICA-**
4 **TION COMMISSION.**

5 (a) EXTENSION OF TIME FOR SUBMISSION OF FINAL
6 REPORT.—Section 402(e)(2) of the Veterans' Benefits
7 Improvements Act of 1994 (Public Law 103–446; 108
8 Stat. 4659) is amended by striking out “Not later than
9 18 months after such date” and inserting in lieu thereof
10 “Not later than December 31, 1996”.

1 (b) FUNDING.—From amounts appropriated to the
2 Department of Veterans Affairs for each of fiscal years
3 1996 and 1997 for the payment of compensation and pen-
4 sion, the amount of \$75,000 is hereby made available for
5 the activities of the Veterans' Claims Adjudication Com-
6 mission under title IV of the Veterans' Benefits Improve-
7 ments Act of 1994 (Public Law 103–446; 108 Stat.
8 4659).
