A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, clarify the intent of Congress with respect to the Federal carjacking prohibition.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Carjacking Correction
5 Act of 1996”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF INTENT OF CONGRESS IN FED-**
2 **ERAL CARJACKING PROHIBITION.**

3 Section 2119(2) of title 18, United States Code, is
4 amended by striking “(as defined in section 1365 of this
5 title)” and inserting “(which, for the purpose of this sec-
6 tion shall have the meaning given that term in section
7 1365 of this title and also include any sexual act, as de-
8 fined in section 2246 of this title)”.

9 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

10 *This Act may be cited as the “Carjacking Correction*
11 *Act of 1996”.*

12 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF INTENT OF CONGRESS IN FED-**
13 **ERAL CARJACKING PROHIBITION.**

14 *Section 2119(2) of title 18, United States Code, is*
15 *amended by inserting “, including any conduct that, if the*
16 *conduct occurred in the special maritime and territorial ju-*
17 *risdiction of the United States, would violate section 2241*
18 *or 2242 of this title” after (as defined in section 1365 of*
19 *this title”.*
