A BILL

To amend title IX of the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965 to make the development of brownfield sites eligible for assistance.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 903 of the Public Works and Economic De-
4 velopment Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3243) is amended—
5 (1) in subsection (a)(1) by inserting after
6 “business development,” the following: “development
7 of brownfield sites,”; and

1 (2) by adding at the end the following:

2 “(e) BROWNFIELD SITE DEFINED.—In this section,
3 the term ‘brownfield site’ means a parcel of land that con-
4 tains or contained abandoned or under-used commercial
5 or industrial facilities the expansion or redevelopment of
6 which is complicated by the presence or potential presence
7 of hazardous substances.”.
