3 order against consideration of the bill are waived. The
4 amendment printed in the report of the Committee on
5 Rules accompanying this resolution shall be considered as
6 adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read.
7 All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amend-
8 ed, are waived. The previous question shall be considered
9 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any amendment
10 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except:
11 (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by
12 the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee
13 on Appropriations; and (2) one motion to recommit with
14 or without instructions.
