A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, concerning employment standards for airport security personnel.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Airport Security Per-
5 sonnel Standards Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS FOR AIRPORT SECURITY**

7 **PERSONNEL.**

8 Section 44935(a) of title 49, United States Code, is
9 amended—

1 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through
2 (5) as subparagraphs (A) through (E), respectively;
3 (2) by striking “The Administrator” and insert-
4 ing “(1) The Administrator”; and
5 (3) by adding at the end the following:
6 “(2) Any standards for airport security personnel
7 prescribed under paragraph (1) shall include requirements
8 for law enforcement or military training.”.
