1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN MATE-**
4 **RIALS.**

5 (a) SPRING STEEL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.72.17	L-shaped edges of spring steel for use in the manufacture of skis and snowboards (provided for in subheading 7217.10.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/98	”.

1 (b) POLYETHYLENE BASE MATERIALS.—Subchapter
2 II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of
3 the United States is amended by inserting in numerical
4 sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.39.20	Polyethylene base materials that are sanded on 1 side and surface-treated for use in the manufacture of skis and snowboards (provided for in subheading 3920.10.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/98	”.
