## A BILL

To amend the Tariff Act of 1930 with respect to the marking of golf clubs and golf club components.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. MARKING OF GOLF CLUBS AND GOLF CLUB**

4                               **COMPONENTS.**

5       Section 304 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C.  
6       1304) is amended—

7               (1) by redesignating subsections (f), (g), (h),

8       and (i) as subsections (g), (h), (i), and (j), respec-

9       tively; and

1           (2) by inserting after subsection (e) the follow-  
2           ing new subsection:

3           “(f) MARKING OF GOLF CLUBS AND GOLF CLUB  
4 COMPONENTS.—The marking requirements of subsections  
5 (a) and (b) shall not apply to—

6           “(1) golf clubs that are assembled, processed,  
7           and finished in the United States; and

8           “(2) golf club components that are imported for  
9           assembling, processing, and finishing into golf clubs  
10          in the United States.”.

11 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

12          The amendments made by section 1 apply to goods  
13 entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption,  
14 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
