A BILL

To amend the Act commonly known as the “Antiquities Act” to limit further extension or establishment of national monuments in California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON FURTHER EXTENSION OR ES-**
4 **TABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN**
5 **CALIFORNIA.**

6 The Act entitled “An Act for the preservation of
7 American antiquities”, approved June 8, 1906 (16 U.S.C.
8 431 et seq.; commonly known as the “Antiquities Act”),
9 is amended by adding at the end the following new section:

1 “SEC. 5. After the effective date of this section, no
2 extension or establishment of any national monument in
3 California may be undertaken except by express authoriza-
4 tion of Congress.”.
