## A BILL

To provide for an extension of H-1 immigration status for certain nonimmigrant nurses.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF H-1 IMMIGRATION STATUS FOR**

4 **CERTAIN NONIMMIGRANT NURSES.**

5 The Attorney General shall provide for the extension  
6 through December 31, 1995, of nonimmigrant status  
7 under section 101(a)(15)(H)(i) of the Immigration and  
8 Nationality Act for an alien to perform services as a reg-  
9 istered nurse in the case of an alien who has had such  
10 status which has not expired as of the date of the enact-

1 ment of this Act but would otherwise expire prior to De-  
2 cember 31, 1995, due to the time limitations with respect  
3 to such status.
