To direct the Secretary of Transportation to study methods to reduce accidents on Federal-aid highways caused by drivers falling asleep while operating certain commercial motor vehicles.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS.**

4 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of Transportation shall
5 conduct a study of methods to reduce accidents on Fed-
6 eral-aid highways caused by drivers falling asleep while op-
7 erating a commercial motor vehicle used to transport
8 freight.

1 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
2 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor-
3 tation shall transmit to Congress a report on the results
4 of the study conducted under subsection (a).
