A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide that remarriage of the surviving spouse of a veteran after age 55 shall not result in termination of dependency and indemnity compensation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 103(d) of title 38, United States Code, is
4 amended by adding the following new paragraph after
5 paragraph (3):

1 “(4) The remarriage after age 55 of a surviving
2 spouse of a veteran shall not bar payment of benefits
3 under section 1311 of this title.”.
