## AN ACT

To prohibit the use of Highway 209 within the Delaware  
Water Gap National Recreation Area by certain commercial  
vehicles, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Effective at noon on September  
5 30, 2005, the use of Highway 209 within Delaware Water  
6 Gap National Recreation Area by commercial vehicles,  
7 when such use is not connected with the operation of the  
8 recreation area, is prohibited, except as provided in sub-  
9 section (b).

1 (b) LOCAL BUSINESS USE PROTECTED.—Subsection  
2 (a) does not apply with respect to the use of commercial  
3 vehicles to serve businesses located within or in the vicinity  
4 of the recreation area, as determined by the Secretary.

5 (c) CONFORMING PROVISIONS.—(1) Paragraphs (1)  
6 through (3) of the third undesignated paragraph under  
7 the heading “ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS” in  
8 chapter VII of title I of Public Law 98–63 (97 Stat. 329)  
9 are repealed, effective September 30, 2005.

10 (2) Prior to noon on September 30, 2005, the Sec-  
11 retary shall collect and utilize a commercial use fee from  
12 commercial vehicles in accordance with paragraphs (1)  
13 through (3) of such third undesignated paragraph. Such  
14 fee shall not exceed \$25 per trip.
