## A BILL

To provide for the improved enforcement of the employer

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEVELOPMENT OF NEW SOCIAL SECURITY**

4 **CARD.**

5 (a) DEVELOPMENT OF NEW CARD.—Not later than  
6 January 1, 1998, the Secretary of Health and Human  
7 Services, acting through the Social Security Administra-  
8 tion and in cooperation with the Attorney General and the  
9 Secretary of Labor, shall consider and develop a counter-

1 fei-resistant social security card which contains finger-  
2 print identification, barcode validation, a photograph, or  
3 some other identifiable feature.

4 (b) WORK AUTHORIZATION DOCUMENT.—Not later  
5 than January 1, 1998, the Attorney General shall des-  
6 ignate the social security card as the single acceptable  
7 work authorization document under the Immigration  
8 Reform and Control Act.
