A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to permit areas not contributing to more than 35 percent of ozone concentrations to comply with Marginal Area requirements for purposes of ozone nonattainment.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RURAL TRANSPORT AREAS.**

4 Section 182(h) of the Clean Air Act is amended by
5 adding the following new paragraph at the end thereof:

6 “(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of section
7 181 or this section, a rural or non rural area shall be

1 treated by operation of law as satisfying the requirements
2 of this section if the State makes the submissions required
3 under subsection (a) of this section (relating to Marginal
4 Areas) for the area and if sources of VOC (and where the
5 Administrator determines relevant, NO_x) emissions within
6 the area do not contribute to more than 35 percent of the
7 ozone concentrations measured in the area or in other
8 areas.”.
