AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey a fish
hatchery to the State of Iowa.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF THE FAIRPORT NATIONAL**
4 **FISH HATCHERY TO THE STATE OF IOWA.**

5 (a) CONVEYANCE.—Within 180 days after the date
6 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior

1 shall convey to the State of Iowa without reimbursement
2 all right, title, and interest of the United States in and
3 to the fish hatchery described in subsection (b) for use
4 by the State for purposes of fishery resources manage-
5 ment.

6 (b) HATCHERY DESCRIBED.—The fish hatchery de-
7 scribed in subsection (a) is the Fairport National Fish
8 Hatchery located in Muscatine County, Iowa, adjacent to
9 State Highway 22 west of Davenport, Iowa, including all
10 real property, improvements to real property, and personal
11 property.

12 (c) USE AND REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—The prop-
13 erty conveyed to the State of Iowa pursuant to this section
14 shall be used by the State for purposes of fishery resources
15 management, and if it is used for any other purpose all
16 right, title, and interest in and to all property conveyed
17 pursuant to this section shall revert to the United States.
