## A BILL

To extend the authorization for appropriations for the Com-  
modity Futures Trading Commission through fiscal year  
2000.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That this Act may be cited as the “Commodity Futures  
4 Trading Commission Reauthorization Act of 1995”.

5 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

6 Section 12(d) of the Commodity Exchange Act (7  
7 U.S.C. 16(d)) is amended to read as follows:

1       “(d) There are authorized to be appropriated such  
2 sums as are necessary for each of the fiscal years 1995  
3 through 2000.”.
