A BILL

To extend the authorization for appropriations for the Commodity Futures Trading Commission through fiscal year 2000.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
- 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That this Act may be cited as the “Commodity Futures
- 4 Trading Commission Reauthorization Act of 1995”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 Section 12(d) of the Commodity Exchange Act (7
3 U.S.C. 16(d)) is amended to read as follows:

4 “(d) There are authorized to be appropriated such
5 sums as are necessary for each of the fiscal years 1995
6 through 2000.”.
