## A BILL

To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to increase the minimum wage.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Minimum Wage  
5 Amendments of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN MINIMUM WAGE.**

7 Section 6(a)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of  
8 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)) is amended by striking out  
9 “and not less than \$4.25 an hour after March 31, 1991”  
10 and inserting in lieu thereof “not less than \$4.25 an hour

1 until the 90th day after the date of enactment of the Mini-  
2 mum Wage Amendments of 1995, and not less than \$6.50  
3 an hour after the 90th day after such date”.
