Mr. MORAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

## A BILL

To abolish the Board of Review of the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ABOLITION OF BOARD OF REVIEW AND RELAT-**

4 **ED AUTHORITY.**

5 (a) ABOLITION OF BOARD OF REVIEW.—Section  
6 6007 of the Metropolitan Washington Airports Act of  
7 1986 (100 Stat. 1783–379) is amended—

8 (1) by striking subsections (f) and (h);

9 (2) by redesignating subsection (g) as sub-  
10 section (f); and

1           (3) by redesignating subsection (i) as subsection  
2           (g).

3           (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

4           (1) RELATIONSHIP TO AND EFFECT OF OTHER  
5           LAWS.—Section 6009(b) of the Metropolitan Wash-  
6           ington Airports Act of 1986 (100 Stat. 1783–384)  
7           is amended by striking “or by reason of the author-  
8           ity” and all that follows through the end of the sub-  
9           section and inserting a period.

10          (2) SEPARABILITY.—Section 6011 of the Met-  
11          ropolitan Washington Airports Act of 1986 (100  
12          Stat. 1783–385) is amended by striking “Except as  
13          provided in section 6007(h), if” and inserting “If”.

14          (c) PROTECTION OF CERTAIN ACTIONS.—Actions  
15          taken by the Airports Authority and submitted to the  
16          Board of Review pursuant to section 6007(f)(4) of the  
17          Metropolitan Washington Airports Act of 1986 before  
18          April 1, 1995, shall remain in effect and shall not be set  
19          aside solely by reason of a judicial order invalidating cer-  
20          tain functions of the Board of Review.

21          (d) AMENDMENT OF LEASE.—The Secretary of  
22          Transportation shall amend the lease entered into with the  
23          Airports Authority under section 6005(a) of the Metro-  
24          politan Washington Airports Act of 1986 to secure the

1 Airports Authority's consent to the amendments made by  
2 this Act.

3 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF RESERVED PARKING AREAS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Effective 30 days after the date  
5 of the enactment of this Act, the Airports Authority shall  
6 not provide any reserved parking areas free of charge to  
7 Members of Congress, other Government officials, or dip-  
8 lomats at Washington National Airport.

9 (b) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this Act, the  
10 terms “Airports Authority”, “Washington National Air-  
11 port”, and “Washington Dulles International Airport”  
12 have the same meanings as in section 6004 of the Metro-  
13 politan Washington Airports Act of 1986.

14 **SEC. 3. CONFORMING AMENDMENTS IN OTHER LAW.**

15 Any reference in any Federal law, Executive order,  
16 rule, regulation, or delegation of authority to the Board  
17 of Review of the Metropolitan Washington Airports Au-  
18 thority or the provisions of law repealed under this Act  
19 is hereby repealed.
