Mr. ROTH introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee
on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Eugene Hasenfus.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF CLAIM.**

4 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any
5 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to Eu-
6 gene Hasenfus of Marinette, Wisconsin, the sum of
7 \$805,209. The payment required by this section shall be
8 in full satisfaction of all claims that Eugene Hasenfus or
9 his family may have against the United States in connec-
10 tion with any physical or mental injury of Eugene
11 Hasenfus, or any financial loss of Eugene Hasenfus or his
12 family, arising from the October 5, 1986, missile attack

1 on the airplane in which he was a crewmember or from
2 his subsequent detention in Nicaragua.

3 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENT AND ATTORNEY FEES.**

4 It shall be unlawful for an amount exceeding 10 per-
5 cent of the payment required by section 1 to be paid to
6 or received by any agent or attorney for any service ren-
7 dered in condition with the payment. Any person violating
8 this section shall be guilty of an infraction, and shall be
9 subject to a fine in the amount provided in title 18, United
10 States Code.
