Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1058) to reform Federal securities litigation, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1058) to reform Federal securities
6 litigation, and for other purposes. The first reading of the
7 bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be con-
8 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-

1 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
2 ity member of the Committee on Commerce. After general
3 debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under
4 the five-minute rule for a period not to exceed eight hours.
5 The bill shall be considered as read. During consideration
6 of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee
7 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the
8 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has
9 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional
10 Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule
11 XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as
12 read. Points of order under clause 7 of rule XVI against
13 the amendments printed in the report of the Committee
14 on Rules accompanying this resolution are waived. At the
15 conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
16 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
17 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
18 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
19 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
20 motion except one motion to recommit.
