Mr. GOSS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1868) making appropriations for foreign operations, export financing, and related programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1868) making appropriations for
6 foreign operations, export financing, and related programs

1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, and for
2 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
3 pensed with. General debate shall be confined to the bill
4 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
5 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
6 the Committee on Appropriations. After general debate
7 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
8 minute rule. The bill shall be considered by title rather
9 than by paragraph. Each title shall be considered as read.
10 Points of order against provisions in the bill for failure
11 to comply with clause 2, 5(b), or 6 of rule XXI are waived.
12 Before consideration of any other amendment it shall be
13 in order to consider the amendments printed in part 1 of
14 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
15 resolution in the order printed. Each of those amendments
16 may be offered only by a Member designated in the report,
17 may amend portions of the bill not yet read for amend-
18 ment, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for
19 ten minutes equally divided and controlled by the pro-
20 ponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-
21 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
22 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
23 Whole. All points of order against amendments printed in
24 part 1 of the report are waived. After disposition of the
25 amendments printed in part 1 of the report, the provisions

1 of the bill as then perfected shall be considered as original
2 text. Points of order against amendments printed in part
3 2 of the report under clause 2 of rule XXI are waived.
4 An amendment printed in part 2 of the report shall not
5 be subject to a demand for division of the question in the
6 House or in the Committee of the Whole. During further
7 consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of
8 the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-
9 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an
10 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
11 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
12 clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be
13 considered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of
14 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-
15 port the bill to the House with such amendments as may
16 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
17 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to
18 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-
19 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
