## RESOLUTION

Providing for the further consideration in the Committee of the Whole of the bill (H.R. 1868) making appropriations for foreign operations, export financing, and related programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That during further consideration of H.R.  
2 1868 pursuant to House Resolution 170, consideration of  
3 the bill for amendment in the Committee of the Whole  
4 House on the state of the Union shall proceed without in-  
5 tervening motion except the amendments printed in the

1 report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this reso-  
2 lution. Each of those amendments may be considered only  
3 in the order printed in the report, may be offered only  
4 by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered  
5 as read, shall be debatable for twenty minutes equally di-  
6 vided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,  
7 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-  
8 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House  
9 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order  
10 against amendments printed in the report are waived. The  
11 chairman of the Committee of the Whole may postpone  
12 until a time during further consideration in the Committee  
13 of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amend-  
14 ment made in order by this resolution. The chairman of  
15 the Committee of the Whole may reduce to not less than  
16 five minutes the time for voting by electronic device on  
17 any postponed question that immediately follows another  
18 vote by electronic device without intervening business, pro-  
19 vided that the time for voting by electronic device on the  
20 first in any series of questions shall be not less than fifteen  
21 minutes. Immediately after disposition of the amendments  
22 printed in the report, the Committee shall rise and report  
23 the bill to the House with such amendments as may have  
24 been adopted.
