Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1976) making appropriations for Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1976) making appropriations for

1 Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Adminis-
2 tration, and Related Agencies programs for the fiscal year
3 ending September 30, 1996, and for other purposes. The
4 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. General
5 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
6 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
7 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-
8 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered
9 for amendment under the five-minute rule, and the
10 amendment printed in the report of the Committee on
11 Rules accompanying this resolution shall be considered as
12 pending. That amendment shall be considered as read,
13 shall be debatable for ten minutes equally divided and con-
14 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
15 the Committee on Appropriations, shall not be subject to
16 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-
17 sion of the question in the House or in the Committee
18 of the Whole. If that amendment is adopted, the provisions
19 of the bill, as amended, shall be considered as the original
20 bill for the purpose of further amendment under the five-
21 minute rule. Further consideration of the bill for amend-
22 ment shall proceed by title rather than by paragraph.
23 Each title shall be considered as read. Points of order
24 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with
25 clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived. During further con-

1 sideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the
2 Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition
3 on the basis of whether the Member offering an amend-
4 ment has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Con-
5 gressional Record designated for that purpose in clause
6 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be consid-
7 ered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
8 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
9 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been
10 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
11 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
12 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
13 with or without instructions.
