Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 2020) making appropriations for the Treasury Department, the United States Postal Service, the Executive Office of the President, and certain independent agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
- 3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 2020) making appropriations for
3 the Treasury Department, the United States Postal Serv-
4 ice, the Executive Office of the President, and certain
5 independent agencies, for the fiscal year ending September
6 30, 1996, and for other purposes. The first reading of the
7 bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be con-
8 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
9 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
10 ity member of the Committee on Appropriations. After
11 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
12 under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be considered
13 by title rather than by paragraph. Each title shall be con-
14 sidered as read. Points of order against provisions in the
15 bill for failure to comply with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI
16 are waived except as follows: beginning with “*Provided*
17 *further*” on page 33, line 2, through “Maryland:” on line
18 13; and page 42, line 9, through page 43, line 6. Where
19 points of order are waived against part of a paragraph,
20 points of order against a provision in another part of such
21 paragraph may be made only against such provision and
22 not against the entire paragraph. During consideration of
23 the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee
24 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the
25 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has

1 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional
2 Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule
3 XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as
4 read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
5 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
6 to the House with such amendments as may have been
7 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
8 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
9 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
10 with or without instructions.
