1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order without intervention of any point of order
3 to take from the Speaker's table the joint resolution (H.J.
4 Res. 115) making further continuing appropriations for
5 the fiscal year 1996, and for other purposes, with any Sen-
6 ate amendments thereto, and to consider in the House a

1 motion offered by the majority leader or his designee to
2 dispose of all Senate amendments. Any Senate amend-
3 ments and the motion shall be considered as read. The
4 motion shall be debatable for one hour equally divided and
5 controlled by the majority leader and the minority leader
6 or their designees. The previous question shall be consid-
7 ered as ordered on the motion to final adoption without
8 intervening motion or demand for division of the question
9 except any such demand made by the majority leader or
10 his designee.
