RESOLUTION

Waiving a requirement of clause 4(b) of rule XI with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules.

1 *Resolved*, That the requirement of clause 4(b) of rule
2 XI for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the
3 Committee on Rules on the same day it is presented to
4 the House is waived with respect to any resolution re-
5 ported on or before the legislative day of November 23,
6 1995, providing for consideration or disposition of any bill
7 or joint resolution that includes provisions making further

1 continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 1996, any
2 amendment thereto, any conference report thereon, or any
3 amendment reported in disagreement from a conference
4 thereon. In no case shall this resolution apply to a resolu-
5 tion providing for consideration or disposition of a bill that
6 is a reconciliation bill within the meaning of section 310
7 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974, any amendment
8 thereto, any conference report thereon, or any amendment
9 reported in disagreement from a conference thereon.
