# RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require a three-fifths vote of the House on passage of any measure carrying an income tax rate increase.

1       *Resolved*, That clause 5 of rule XXI of the Rules of  
2 the House of Representatives is amended by adding at the  
3 end the following new paragraph:

4       “(c) No bill, joint resolution, amendment, or con-  
5 fference report carrying an income tax rate increase could  
6 be considered as passed or agreed to unless so determined  
7 by a vote of at least three-fifths of the House.”.
