

H. Res. 273

In the House of Representatives, U.S.,

November 17, 1995.

Resolved, That upon the adoption of this resolution it shall be in order without intervention of any point of order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 2606) to prohibit the use of funds appropriated to the Department of Defense from being used for the deployment on the ground of United States Armed Forces in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina as part of any peacekeeping operation, or as part of any implementation force, unless funds for such deployment are specifically appropriated by law. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and any amendment thereto to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill, which shall be equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on National Security; (2) one motion to amend by the minority leader or his designee, which shall be considered as read, and shall be separately debatable for one hour equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one motion to re-

commit, which may include instructions only if offered by the minority leader or his designee.

SEC. 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of this resolution, if the minority leader or his designee announces that an amendment will not be offered, there shall be an additional period of one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on National Security.
