RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of a motion to dispose of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 1643) to authorize the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment (most-favored-nation treatment) to the products of Bulgaria.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (H.R. 1643) to authorize the extension of nondiscrim-
4 inatory treatment (most-favored-nation treatment) to the
5 products of Bulgaria, with the Senate amendment thereto,
6 and to consider in the House the motion printed in the

1 report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this reso-
2 lution. The Senate amendment and the motion shall be
3 considered as read. All points of order against the motion
4 are waived. The motion shall be debatable for one hour
5 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
6 ing minority member of the Committee on Appropriations.
7 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
8 the motion to final adoption without intervening motion
9 or demand for division of the question.
